- 1) Please let us know your current Mathematics course taken in 8th grade, and expected course to take in 9th grade. We will confirm these requests over summer with placement testing.
- 2) Please let us know your World Language selection. Students may choose to begin their language journey with Spanish or French Principles. If students have

previous experience, they may enroll in Spanish, French, or Latin Intermediate A. We will confirm these requests over summer with placement testing.

- 3) All freshmen participate in a Performing Art. Students may choose a yearlong course in Band, Strings, or Choir, or students may select three trimesters (1 year) of Theatre Arts offerings. Please note that Band and Strings require previous experience. Reference the course brochure for the Theatre course titles and descriptions, as well as which trimester each course is offered. Please be aware that Theatre trimester courses are offered in a variety of periods and may not fit in their schedule depending on math and language placement. Other course choices and adjustment opportunities will be available.
