# Wellington After School Activities (WASA) 2021-2022

Wellington After School Activities (WASA) provides a variety of exciting opportunities for lower school and middle school students. The goal of WASA is to provide programming that is creative, inspiring, fun, and safe.

# Early Childhood and Lower School Aftercare

On regular school days, Aftercare is provided at no cost to students in Little Jags, prekindergarten, and kindergarten. For students who are in 1<sup>st</sup> grade through 4<sup>th</sup> grade Aftercare costs \$15 a day and is billed each month through Veracross. The program starts at the end of the school day till 6pm. Students can come as little as one day or for the full week.

# Is Registration Required?

Yes. You must register to use Aftercare. More information about registration will go out before the start of school.

# Are Drop-in's Allowed?

Drop ins are allowed but must be commutated with the Director of Aftercare, Becca Kelly at kelly@wellington.org before 1:00 pm day of.

# Who Teaches Aftercare?

Our Aftercare teachers are a combination of current Wellington Upper School students, college students and Wellington faculty. Every Aftercare teachers is background checked.

# What do students do in Aftercare?

Extended day will consist of both indoor and outdoor open play actives such as crafts, group games, and STEM actives.

# Do you offer snacks during Aftercare?

Stacks are offered during aftercare and typically consist of gram crackers, pretzels, veggie straws, and gold fish. Students with specific diets or food allergies are encouraged to pack their own snack.

# How do I pick up my child from Aftercare?

Simply enter into the Rotunda and we will bring your child to you.

# Professional Days, Late Start Days and Parent Teacher Conferences Childcare

Childcare is offered for Little Jags through 4<sup>th</sup> grade on days then school is not in session. Specific dates and sign up will be announced through the Bugle and weekly emails. Registration for these days will open two weeks before the date and space may be limited. Early Childhood families are required to pay for this service.

# After School Enrichment
